Declaration

K.Hartwall Oy Ab, hereby declares that we are committed to sustainability and complying with all applicable requirements relating to packaging, packaging materials and chemical substance restrictions under European Union legislation.

Based on supplier declarations, material specifications and available technical documentation and conformity assessment processes, K. Hartwall confirms the following:

1. PPWR Compliance

This declaration applies to K.Hartwall's reusable transport packaging and load carrier solutions, including trays, dollies, adaptor pallets, roll containers, cages and other reusable logistics and transport packaging products. These products are intended for the transport, storage and handling of goods throughout the supply chain.

K. Hartwall declares that:

- Products, packaging materials and packaging components within the scope of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR) comply with applicable substance restrictions, including requirements relating to the combined concentration of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI))
- The products are designed and manufactured with consideration for recyclability, reusability, material efficiency and sustainable resource utilization
- Materials used in products and packaging are evaluated against applicable PPWR requirements and available supplier information relating to packaging composition, recyclability and environmental performance
- Where required, supplier declarations, technical documentation and material information are collected and maintained to support conformity verification.

- K.Hartwall maintains procedures for monitoring regulatory developments and implementing necessary product or packaging updates to ensure ongoing compliance.

2. PFAS

Unless otherwise specified in product-specific documentation, K.Hartwall's products are not intended for direct contact with food.

- Based on supplier information and available technical documentation, K. Hartwall does not intentionally add PFAS substances to its products or packaging materials unless specifically identified, technically required and permitted by applicable legislation.
- K.Hartwall evaluates received information and follows developments concerning emerging PFAS restrictions within the European Union.

3. Supplier Management and Due Diligence

K.Hartwall operates a supplier management process intended to support compliance with applicable environmental and chemical regulations.

This process includes, where applicable:

- Collection of material declarations.
- Supplier compliance confirmations.
- Regulatory change management.
- Technical documentation maintenance.
- Risk-based verification activities.

4. Limitations

This declaration is based upon information available to K.Hartwall at the date of issue, including supplier-provided information and technical documentation.

This declaration constitutes a general corporate compliance statement and does not replace:

- Product-specific Declarations of Conformity
- Material-specific test reports
- PPWR technical documentation

- Regulatory certifications required by law
